St Monica's Vinnies Appeal - Solomon Islands: weekend of 11/12 November

In 2020 we partnered with a Vinnies group in a remote part of the Solomon Islands - St Theresa, in the small town of takwa. Last year, St Monica's parishioners donated over \$4000 to assist this group. We disbursed most of the funds on two key projects; (1) manual sewing machines, cloth and other sewing items and; (2) the second phase of purchasing piglets for needy families in the village. Given some administrative delays in the Solomon Islands, these projects have only recently been rolled out. We have received extensive reports and photos on the successful implementation of phase one of the piggery project. The villagers are thrilled with our support and have asked for further assistance in 2024 including to assist with education scholarships through the Vinnies national 'Assist a Student' program. The Vinnies group visits the sick and elderly and provides food, often from their own vegetable gardens. We would be grateful for your generous support for our Appeal at the masses on 11&12 November to continue our practical assistance to the vulnerable members of the Takwa village community.
