# Archdiocesan Protocols as of January 2022

Facemasks are mandatory in churches. The 2sqm per person rule applies for inside the church. Congregational singing is not permitted. Holy Communion may be received in the hand only. Catechists in the parish are required to be fully vaccinated.

#### Parish Sacramental Program 2022 If you have a child in years 3, 4 or 6 in 2022, this will be a Sacramental year.

This applies also if your child is in year 5 and he/she has previously missed the sacraments of Reconciliation and/or First Eucharist.
