Sunday Mass

Due to the restriction of a maximum of twenty people, (excluding the celebrant), being permitted to gather in the church. Sunday Masses in our parish will not recommence until the next stage of the Covid-19 recovery plan.

Midweek and Saturday Mass

Masses from Tuesday to Saturday have now recommenced in our parish, with a maximum of twenty people permitted, excluding the celebrant. Please book a place for Mass using the online booking system: https://olph.link/signup.

Alternatively, you may leave a message on the parish office phone, giving your name and the date of the Mass you would like to attend.

Prayers and Devotions in the Church Groups of up to twenty people who already possess a key to the church, may gather for prayers or devotions, observing the social distancing rule of 1.5 metres.

Hygiene in the Church
