Parish Sacramental Program 2023

Sacrament of Confirmation - will be celebrated on: Tuesday 5 September 2023 at 6pm in St Michael's Church, Kaleen; Wednesday 6 September 2023 at 6pm in St Monica's Church, Evatt; and Thursday 7 September 2023 at 6pm in St Monica's Church, Evatt.

Important - please talk to your child and regarding the 'Saint's Name' and their 'Sponsor', as these are requirements on the registration form. The sponsor should be a baptised catholic and not a parent. The role of the sponsor should be someone who has an influence in the child's life and can fill in the gaps where the parent is unable to. Registrations are open and will **close by Friday 21 July 2023**. Registration for the Sacrament **must** be via the Our Lady of Perpetual Help Qkr! App (**NOT** the school app). If you are registering more than 1 child you will need to fully complete and pay for each separate registration. **No late registrations** will be accepted after the closing date.
