

Archdiocesan Protocols *RE: The CoronaVirus (COVID-19)*

The Archdiocese has received advice from medical experts that we should employ best *practice* and be *prudent* in trying to help reduce the transmission of the *CoronaVirus* (*COVID-19*).

Upon reception of this letter, all communities, parishes, schools, hospitals, etc. are asked to observe the following *protocols*, with appropriate instructions given to the faithful, until further notice:

- 1. Remove Holy Water from fonts.
- 2. Ask the faithful to acknowledge each other at the sign of peace, but refrain from touching.
- 3. Priests, Deacons, Acolytes and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to use hand sanitiser **before** distributing Holy Communion and **after** distributing Holy Communion at Mass, Liturgy of the Word's with Holy Communion, Visits to the sick in Hospital and Home.
- 4. Instruct the faithful that Holy Communion should be received only in the hand, not on the tongue.
- 5. Distribute the Sacred Host only and <u>not</u> the Precious Blood.
