

## Archdiocesan Protocols COVID 19 Explanatory Note

After an update from Calvary Public and Private Hospitals on the *transmission risks* associated with *COVID 19*, priests and parishes are to observe the following:

- 1. Priests only to visit hospitals, aged care homes, and private homes for the anointing of the sick:
  - a. If the person to be anointed has *COVID 19*, then *Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) must* be used.
    - i. *PPE* will be obtainable at the <u>hospital</u>.
    - ii. *PPE* can be obtained through the Vicar General for visits to <u>aged</u> <u>care homes</u> and <u>private homes</u>.
  - b. If the person to be anointed does not have *COVID 19*, then the usual sanitising protocols should be followed prior to and after the anointing.
  - c. When anointing, laying on of hands above the head. Oil of the Sick administered only with gloves, using cotton buds/swabs.
- 2. Priests, Acolytes and Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion are strongly advised *not* to take Communion to sick persons until further notice. Keeping contact via phone and other mediums is highly recommended.
- 3. Proper hand hygiene (use soap and water both before and after encounters with others) is essential.
- 4. Physical distancing is essential.
- 5. When using communal areas, wiping down various appliances, instruments and furniture is essential.
