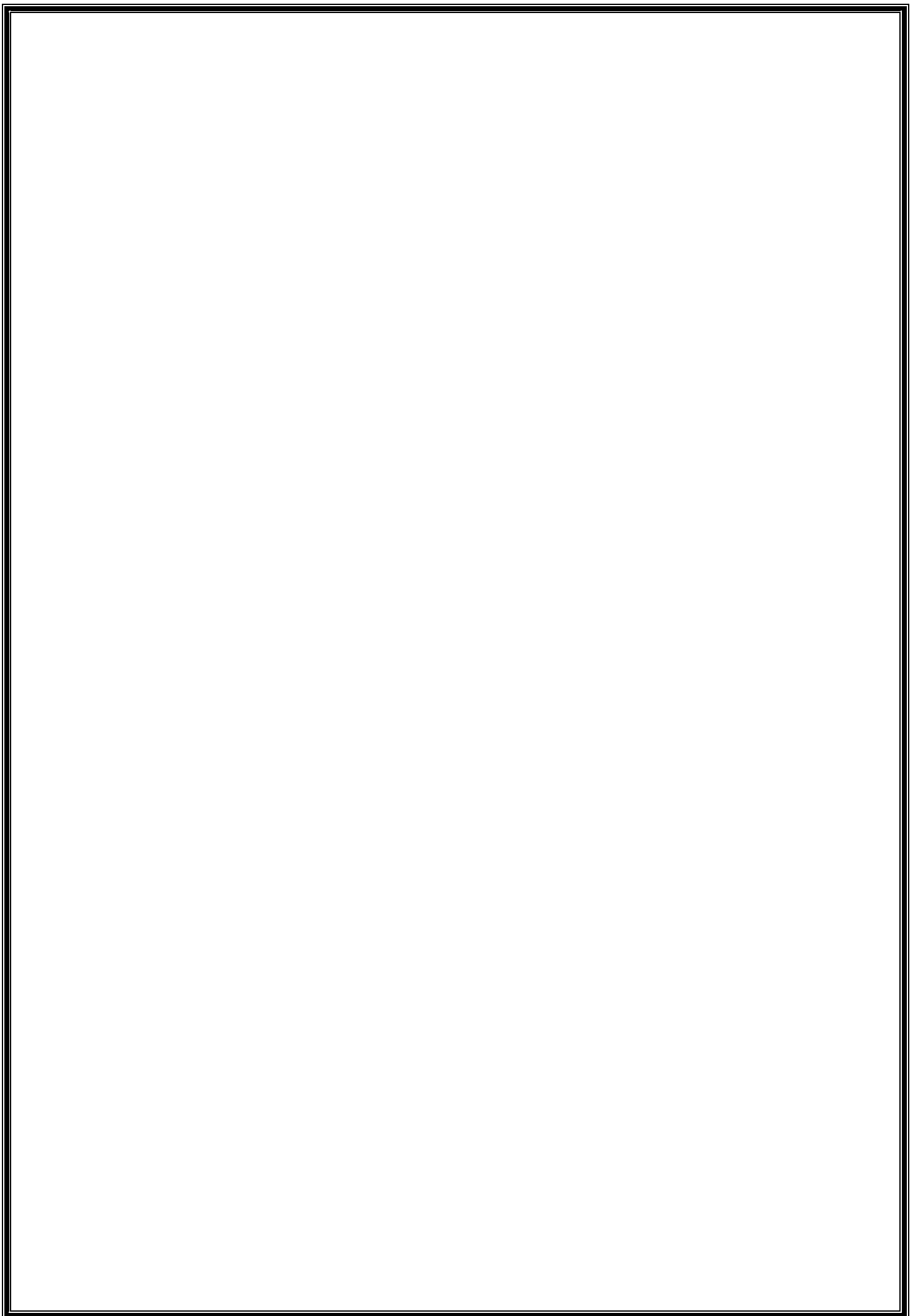

ENTRANCE HYMN

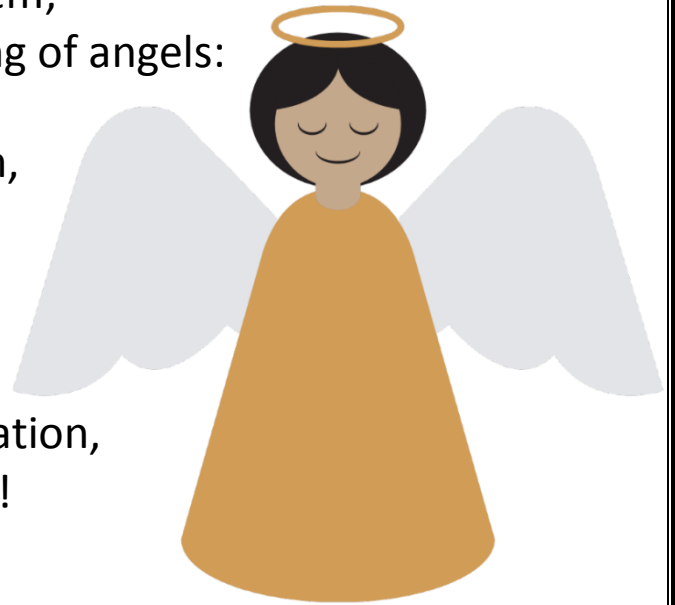
O Come All Ye Faithful

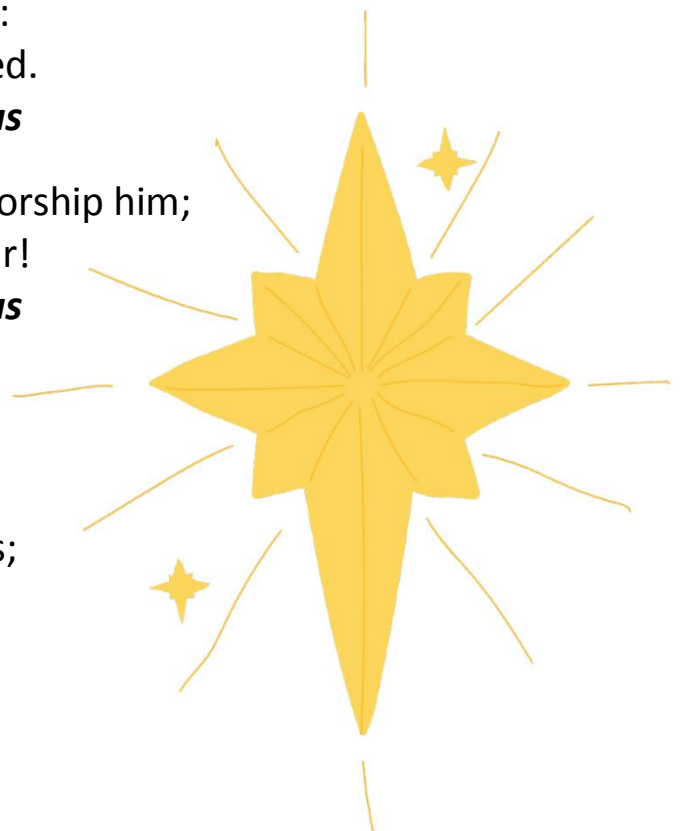
