The Parish Child Protection Subcommittee was pleased to welcome about 60 people to the courtyard outside the Marian Hall at St Matthews on Sunday 8 April, Divine Mercy Sunday. Most people were from the parish, but some had travelled from further afield to be with us.

The Prayer Gathering was conducted in a simple and meaningful manner. The prayers, Gospel reading, hymns and sprinkling of ashes, water and petals, were designed to remember our past of sexual abuse in the parish and look to the future. Many people chose to stay for a cuppa and a chat after the service.

We were pleased to be joined by Archbishop Prowse for such a significant occasion, and were grateful for his words of blessing for the tree and the plaque.

The Subcommittee appreciates the support shown for this project over 2 years, from many individuals, groups and agencies, both from within the parish and beyond. In particular we want to acknowledge the generosity of the St Matthew's Gardening Group.

We are hoping to have a copy of the prayer service booklet and a photo of the tree and plaque up on the parish website soon.
