Aranda Parish Centre Renovations

The Trustees of the Archdiocese of Canberra Goulburn have approved an application from the parish to renovate the Parish Centre at Aranda. This involves an expanded parish meeting area to accommodate both current and future needs, asbestos removal, new kitchen facilities and toilet facilities that meet the standards for disability access as required by planning guidelines for such a centre. In addition a disability access ramp will be constructed for the centre.

Construction work is scheduled to commence shortly and is likely to take approximately three months.

The total project cost including architect fees, engineering cost and final certification costs, painting (which will be done by volunteers) is estimated to be \$300,000.

The funds needed for this work can be drawn from our current reserves and we will not need to borrow any money for this project.
