As per Updated Diocesan Protocols re COVID-19 CoronaVirus (25 March)

Churches are CLOSED 24 hours each day.

There are NO catechetical, spiritual or social gatherings in parishes.

Given that Churches are closed, the following liturgical and pastoral protocols are to be followed, without exemption.

- No public Masses are to be celebrated until further notice.
- No Communion to sick persons in hospitals, aged care homes or private homes until further notice.
- Priests must use Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), i.e. gown, gloves, mask, goggles, when visiting sick person in hospital, aged care homes and private homes.
- Graveside funerals only with a max of 10 people, including celebrant.
- Weddings to be conducted outside sacred space only, with a max of 5 people, including the celebrant.
- Baptisms suspended until further notice, unless emergency.
- Ist rite of penance conducted in an open space observing 1.5m spacing. Persons under 18 with adult supervision.
- There will be no liturgical celebrations with a congregation for Holy Week.
