Liturgy Line

Another Solemnity is upon us, that of the Most Holy Trinity. Our Liturgy is highly trinitarian. As Liturgist, Kevin Irwin, says:"We address God the Father, pray through the Son, in the power of the Holy Spirit." (The Sacraments 2016: 307ff). He continues to remind us that the Eucharistic Prayers of the Mass praise the Father, call to mind the saving deeds of the life, death and resurrection of the Son, and ask the Holy Spirit to be among us. We conclude all Masses and all major liturgies by asking the Holy Trinity to bless us all.

Over the past few weeks, our parishioners have had the opportunity to provide thoughts and suggestions for the theme 'humble, healing and merciful' in relation to the Australian Church, as we prepare for the **Plenary Council**. About a dozen people in the parish took advantage of this opportunity to offer their ideas.

As facilitator of this process, Beth Gibson, gathered these ideas, grouped them into themes and actions, received feedback, and has now submitted them to the writing group for this theme.

While the writing groups have already produced some information, Beth still forwarded our submission this week.

Safeguarding in our parish in Covid-19 times

During this COVID-19 pandemic we are encouraged to stay at home as much as possible.

However, for many people, including victim-survivors of family violence, being at home is not always a safe place to be. Research and evidence shows that family violence can become more frequent and severe during periods of hardship or emergency. For many people, measures introduced to reduce the spread of COVID-19 such as social distancing and self-isolation, as well as increased financial insecurity and use of alcohol or other drugs, and reduced ability to leave relationships, may increase their risk of family violence. Children can be particularly vulnerable to either directly experience or witness family violence.

Times of stress and hardship are never an excuse for violence. All people deserve to live safely in their homes, free from fear and family violence.

There may be families in our parish who have never had to think about family violence before, but now it has become a real risk, or even a reality.

As a parish that values the safety and wellbeing of all people, especially children and vulnerable young people and adults, we encourage anyone who is concerned about family violence to contact one of the services listed below.
