Parish News

RCIA

RCIA stands for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. It is a process offered by parishes to adults interested in finding out more about our faith with a view to becoming Catholics. Those who are unbaptised are called "catechumens" and those who have been baptised in another denomination are called "candidates". The process helps the participants to understand the teachings and practices of the Church and to introduce them to the Mystery of Christ. They are helped to develop their prayer life and are encouraged to share the gospel in their words and actions.

The process is gradual, taking place over a period of months and is divided into four periods that are punctuated by two major liturgical rites. It culminates in the third liturgical rite which includes the celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation i.e. Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. ("Candidates" will receive Confirmation and Eucharist as they have already been baptised}. Often the third step is celebrated at the Easter Vigil Mass.

Information about Christmas Masses this year

Please ensure when entering the church or playground:

- Sanitise your hands;
- Check in/register your attendance;
- Apply the 2sqm rule for physical distancing while seated, standing and moving around the church/playground (families can sit together);
- Holy Communion only under the species of bread;
- Holy Communion to be received only in the hand;
- No touching at the sign of peace;
- Collection plates will not be passed around (collection points are located at the back of the churches)
- Singing is possible, respecting the 2sqm rule, with people facing the same direction.

As we are expecting many people to attend our Christmas Masses, we must ensure that the above **Archdiocesan Protocols re COVID 19 (effective from 4 December)** are followed. There will be two options for entering our churches and school playground for Mass:

- * Using the **Check In CBR app** (information about this app is below)
- * Signing the register provided.

Christmas Eve 6.30pm Children's Mass at St Vincent's Primary School, undercover area of playground - There will be two tents/tables set up for two lines as you enter the playground. One line will for using the Check In CBR app (*QR Code* will be displayed) and the other line for signing the register. As we do not expect there will be 500 people attending this Mass, we will not be keeping count. Please bring your own chairs and blankets. A water station is available but please bring your own water bottle. An electronic copy of the Christmas Eve Mass booklet can be found at <u>https://bit.ly/34fwgai</u>.

Christmas Eve & Day 9pm & 8.30am Masses at St Matthew's Church, Page - There will be three lines when entering the church. One line for using **Check In CBR** (*QR Code* will be displayed) through the left hand door at the main entrance to the church. The two other lines will be for those who cannot use Check In CBR and you will need to **sign the register** - through the right hand door at the main entrance and also through the Marian Hall courtyard and into the foyer. There will be counters just inside the church to keep count and will make sure we have no more than 200 people entering the church. There will be some chairs provided (or bring your own) outside the church. Water will be provided but please bring your own water bottle. Please note: the Christmas Eve 9pm Mass will be streamed https://www.facebook.com/southbelconnen/live/.

Christmas Day 10am Mass at St Vincent's Church, Aranda - There will be two lines when entering the main doors of the church. One line for using **Check In CBR** (*QR Code* will be displayed) and the other line for signing the register. There will be counters just inside the church to keep count and will make sure we have no more than 200 people entering the church. There will be some chairs provided (or bring your own) outside the church. Water will be provided but please bring your own water bottle.

The South Belconnen parish has registered to use **Check In CBR** app at both our churches for ongoing support of the COVID-19 contact tracing efforts. Many restaurants and cafes are using this app around Canberra so some parishioners may already be set up to use this check in technology. When the Check In App is used, the information is directly stored with

ACT Health (for contact tracing purposes only) - the parish will not be able to see who has used this app.

The QR code posters are displayed on the tables in the foyer of each church.

Parishioners who wish to use the app will need to download the Check In CBR App from the Google Play Store or the Apple App Store. You will need to register your details (required for the first time only). Open the app, select 'check in now' and hover your smartphone camera over the venue's displayed QR Code. There are instruction sheets in each of the church foyers.

Please note: This app does not count the number of people in the church at one time because the information goes directly to ACT Health. For this reason, we will still need to sign in for weekend Masses to monitor numbers.

Blessing of the Advent Wreath

(The Presider, or an assistant light the fourth candle, which is often named the Angel Gabriel Candle for those messengers who bring God's Word into our world.)

Celebrant: Lord Jesus, you established the house of David to be secure forever and from which the Saviour would be born (First Reading). Jesus is the cornerstone. We are a Christ-centered Church.

All: Come, Lord Jesus.

Celebrant: Lord Jesus, you alone are wisdom and as St Paul declares, you will give us the strength to live the Gospel (Second Reading). By living a prayerful life Centered on the Eucharist may we open ourselves to your wisdom and the Spirit working in the community.

All: Come, Lord Jesus.

Celebrant: Lord Jesus, you sent the angel Gabriel to give the good news to Mary so that she would bring Jesus into the world through the power of the Spirit (Gospel). Giving birth is painful. Change can be frightening. Mary trusted in God and let herself be led by the Holy Spirit so that we can say:

All: Come, Lord Jesus.
