Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary Feast - 31 May

This feast, celebrating Mary's visit to her kinswoman, Elizabeth, was introduced into the Franciscan calendar by St Bonaventure in the thirteenth century. It was then extended, in 1389, by Urban VI to the entire Latin Church as a means of healing divisions in the Western Church at the time.

This most wonderful meeting of these two mothers-to-be led Elizabeth to exclaim, "Blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb". Mary then responded with her song of praise, the Magnificat. *Liturgy Committee*
