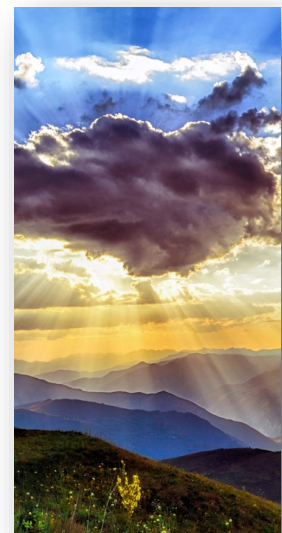

### St Martin of Tours – Feast Day is 11 November – Patron of the poor, soldiers, conscientious objectors, tailors, and winemakers

Martin was born in early 4<sup>th</sup> Century in Pannonia (now Hungary), just after Christianity was legalised, however grew up in northern Italy. At the age of 15, Martin was required to follow his father into the cavalry corps of the Roman military. As a young soldier, Martin encountered a beggar in Amiens, France. The beggar was unclothed, and it was very cold. Martin removed his cloak and with his sword, he cut it in half. He gave this half to the beggar and dressed himself in the remnant. That night, Martin had a vision in which Christ appeared to him, and it was then that he became deeply dedicated to Christianity. Martin left the military when he was about 20, conscientiously objecting to engaging in armed combat.



Martin then moved to Tours to immerse himself in Christianity studies. Later he had another vision, this time Christ telling him to return to his mother in Pannonia. He converted her to Christianity. He then became very involved in countering the Arian heresy, which denied the divinity of Jesus Christ. The reaction against him was so violent from the Arian leaders that he was compelled to flee, and he took up residence on an island in the Adriatic where he lived as a hermit for a time.

Martin returned to Tours and was given a small grant of land where he and his disciples lived. Martin established a monastery which would be inhabited by the Benedictines. The abbey remains to this day. From the site of his abbey, Martin worked to bring people to faith in Jesus Christ and Baptism into His Church in the surrounding areas. He was an extraordinary evangelist. (*Liturgy Committee*)

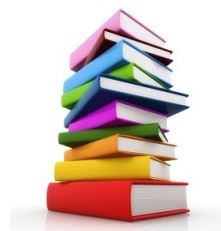
