- compilation of some annual archdiocesan reports

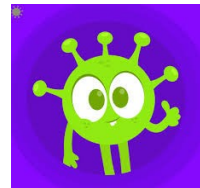
The requirements for this position are: good communication and organisational skills, experience in an office environment, proficiency in Microsoft Word, and a respect and an understanding of the Catholic Church.
