


Liturgy Line

The 2022 Daily Mass Books in our two churches contain basic details of her life (page 482). Mary pioneered a new form of religious life in the order of "The Sisters of St Joseph of the Sacred Heart", initially from 1866 to provide education to families living in isolated

and remote areas of Australia. She took her first Vows as a Religious on 15 August 1867.


Marian Movement of Priests Cenacle
