Our Lady and Founders of Religious Orders

The Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is to be celebrated by another special Monday Mass at St Matthew's Church Page, at 6pm on the 15 August. Her passing from life to heaven of both her body and soul had been celebrated in the Catholic Church for over 1500 years and was confirmed by Pope Pius 12 in 1950.

The devotion to and invocation of, Jesus or Mary, have been the inspirations of many people to start religious orders and to later be canonised. Some recent Saint's Feast days were: on 1 August St Alphonsis Liguori – Redemptorists from 1749 (and icon of Our Lady of Perpetual Help) and St Peter Julian Eymard – Priests and Sisters of the Most Blessed Sacrament from 1857; 3rd St Dominic – Order of Preachers, Dominican Friars, nuns and Third Order laity 1206-12; 8th St Mary of the Cross Mackillop - Sisters of St Joseph of the Sacred Heart 1867; 11th St Clare of Assisi – Poor Clares 1212.

In ending this Australian Week of Prayer for Vocations we pray for more workers in the spiritual vineyard for both diocesan and religious orders. -Liturgy Committee
