

More about Our Lady and Founders of Religious Orders

On the 22 August we celebrate the minor feast of Queenship of Mary (proclaimed 1969). This is now linked to the Assumption of 15 August and these events have long been a guide for our meditation as the Fourth and Fifth Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary. While the Rosary is not liturgical, it forms a trusted for many outside of Mass.

Some more Founders of Religious orders celebrated this month: 19th August St John Eudes – Congregation of the Hearts of Jesus and Mary 1643, seminaries and (with St Margaret-Mary Alacoque) devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus 1670-85; 20th St Bernard of Clairvaux – the Cistercians from 1112 (by his death, 68 monasteries); 26th St Elizabeth Bichier (des Ages) – Daughters of the Cross 1807 (her service preceding and similar to our Mary Mackillop's) - of sisters in small French towns. teaching children, caring for the sick and of her great travelling – 60 convents by 1830. -Liturgy Committee
