# Parish contribution to the Synod on Synodality

The Parish Pastoral Council hosted an open parish meeting on 6 March 2024 to discuss the Synod on Synodality *Synthesis Report.* We did this in response to an invitation from the Vicar General for the Archdiocese, Fr Richard Thompson, to provide our response to a consultation document prepared by the Australian Catholic Bishops' Conference.

The meeting was attended by twenty parishioners and five key points were agreed by the PPC to go forward to the Archdiocese. Our response endorsed the steps being taken towards a more synodal church. We supported the formation of diocesan pastoral councils and increased support for pastoral councils generally. We asked for increased transparency and accountability in all aspects of church governance. We supported the ordination of women to the diaconate and the priesthood. We asked for greater support for lay charisms and ministries to

help us realise our parish vision. A copy of the input can be found on the parish website.

Our parish's input was the only contribution received from the Archdiocese. The Vicar General has advised that our input has been forwarded to the body coordinating the Australian church response.

**Parish Safeguarding Commitment**: The Parish of St Matthew and St Vincent de Paul is committed to safeguarding and upholding the dignity and rights of all of our children and vulnerable people. We seek to empower children, their families and carers, and vulnerable people, to have a say, to be listened to, and to be protected.
