

**Word of God Sunday,** instituted by Pope Francis in the apostolic letter *Aperuit Illis* in 2019, encourages the celebration, study and dissemination of the Word of God. Pope Francis proposed setting aside 'a Sunday given over entirely to the word of God, so as to appreciate the inexhaustible riches contained in the constant dialogue between the Lord and his people'. Pope Francis wants to make it clear how important it is in the daily life of the Church and our communities to refer to the Word of God, a Word that is not confined to a book, but which remains ever alive and becomes a concrete and tangible sign. It is an opportunity to reflect on what room we make in our lives for the scriptures. Pope Francis explains that the Word of God *calls everyone to conversion,* to change our lives, as we cannot remain the same after hearing its life-giving message. 'There is a risk for all of us: overwhelmed by a barrage of words, we let the word of God glide by us: we hear it, yet we fail to listen to it; we listen to it, yet we don't keep it; we keep it, yet we don't let it provoke us to change.' However, "When it enters us, the Word transforms our hearts and minds; it changes us and leads us to direct our lives to the Lord...Here is Jesus' invitation: God has come close to you; recognise His presence, make room for His Word, and you will change your outlook on life."
