Let's look at the Gospel

Jesus tells a story of a landowner who hires workers and tells them, "I will pay you whatever is right." Then at the end of the day, the owner does exactly what he said he'd do, he pays the workers what is right; he pays them fairly.

But, the workers are not happy. They are upset is because there were some other workers that started working later in the day, but they got paid the same amount as the first workers did! In other words, the second set of workers received the same amount of money for doing less work.

Because the first set of workers were so worried about other things, they missed out on the good news. They missed out on the fact that they had been treated very well and very fairly by the land owner. God loves us and treats us very well, BUT, If we decide to focus on what other people are getting, then we will miss out on what God is giving to us.


