Fr Trenton is a Canberra boy, born and bred. Graduating in 2007 from Marist College, Pearce, Fr Trenton entered the Good shepherd Seminary, Sydney in 2008 and later studied overseas. He was ordained deacon in Saint Peter's Basilica in October of 2014, and later a priest at Saint Christopher's on 28th Augusts 2015. In 2016 he was appointed as Assistant Priest of the Temora Mission, as well as the West Wyalong Mission, also spending time in Lake Cargelligo up until mid-2018. He was Assistant priest of Young from mid-2018 before being appointed Administrator of Saint Christopher's Cathedral Parish in June of 2019.
