The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) program
continues on Wednesday, 26 September 2018 at
7.00pm. It will be held in the Haydon Hall, St Chris-
topher's Pastoral Centre, 55 Franklin Street, For-
rest. Each session will run for approximately an hour
and half on Wednesday evenings during school term
time (there will be no meetings during school holidays).
Even though the aim of the course is for the partici-
pants to receive the sacraments of initiation during the
Easter festivities next year, 2019, the course will contin-
ue after Easter to complete all the important topics that
need to be covered. This program is for both adults and
teenagers who are interested in being Catholic or those
who are baptised Catholic and need to complete the sac-
raments of initiation, i.e. Reconciliation, Holy Commun-
ion and Confirmation and those baptised into Protestant
Churches, i.e. Anglican (Church of England), Uniting,
Presbyterian, etc, who would like to be received into full
communion into the Catholic church. The book, "At
Home with God's People", that we will be using for the
course, can be purchased for \$19.
