Dear Friends,

I write to inform you that I have accepted a request from <u>FR WARRICK TONKIN</u> to resign from his role as Administrator of St Christopher's Cathedral Parish due to medical reasons.

This resignation includes his roles as Director of Formation of the Permanent Diaconate, Chairman of the Liturgical Commission, Diocesan Censor and Master of Ceremonies.

Although, recovering well from his recent heart surgery, his physician has written to me recommending that Fr Warrick take early retirement commencing immediately. I have accepted this recommendation, after discussions with Fr Warrick, effective 1st of December 2018.

I am sure you will join me in praying that Fr Warrick will now move into this next more contemplative phase of living out his priesthood with his typical grace and dedication.
