STATEMENT BY ARCHBISHOP CHRISTOPHER PROWSE REGARDING THE SENTENCING OF CARDINAL GEORGE PELL— Wed, 13 March 2019 The conviction and now sentencing of Cardinal Pell has profoundly disturbed the Catholic Community in the Archdiocese of Canberra and Goulburn/Diocese of Wagga Wagga.
