Farewell Father Laurie Blake

Fr Laurie Blake entered his eternal reward last Wednesday, 9th February, after a long and difficult health battle which stretched over many years. We mourn Fr Laurie's death, and yet give joyful thanks for the gift of his life of service and persevering hope, witnessed by him to so many.

Laurie was born in Goulburn, on October 15, 1937. As a child he attended St Brigid's and St Patrick's Primary School, and later, St Patrick's Technical High and St Patrick's College, Goulburn.

From 1956 at the age of 19, Laurie entered St Columba's College Springwood until 1960, when he entered St Patrick's College, Manly from 1961–1964. He was then ordained a deacon at St Patrick's Manly, and a priest on the 15th of December 1964 in Sts Peter and Paul, Goulburn, through the hands of Archbishop Eris O'Brien.

Fr Laurie served in Temora, Queanbeyan, Cooma, and Tumut; as well as having the roles of Chaplain to Kenmore Hospital, the Goulburn and Cooma Gaols, and the NSW Police Force. Fr Laurie was the loved parish priest of both Goulburn (1981) and South Woden (2003), before retiring in 2014.

Passionate about Catechetics and the young, some will recall his service for some years as chaplain to the YCS movement and his heavy involvement in the organising of summer camps and National Conferences.

We commend Fr Laurie to the grace and mercy of the God whom he served so faithfully and generously. Fr Laurie, may you now rest in the peace of Christ, and may you rise in Glory on the last day.

We thank God for your life, and for your priesthood. And we thank you for bringing us the presence and friendship of our God.

A Requiem Mass for our brother, Father Laurie, will be offered at 11am, at Our Lady of Fatima, North Goulburn, on the 17 February. A vigil will also be held at St Michael's, Bungonia, at 6pm, 16 February. Details will be on our website

First Reading Jer 17:5-8

The Lord says this: 'A curse on the man who puts his trust in man, who relies on things of flesh, whose heart turns from the Lord. He is like dry scrub in the wastelands: if good comes, he has no eyes for it, he settles in the parched places of the wilderness, a salt land, uninhabited. 'A blessing on the man who puts his trust in the Lord, with the Lord for his hope. He is like a tree by the waterside that thrusts its roots to the stream: when the heat comes it feels no alarm, its foliage stays green; it has no worries in a year of drought, and never ceases to bear fruit.'

Second Reading 1 Cor 15:12, 16-20

If Christ raised from the dead is what has been preached, how can some of you be saying that there is no resurrection of the dead? For if the dead are not raised, Christ has not been raised, and if Christ has not been raised, you are still in your sins. And what is more serious, all who have died in Christ have perished. If our hope in Christ has been for this life only, we are the most unfortunate of all people. But Christ has in fact been raised from the dead, the first-fruits of all who have fallen asleep.

Gospel Lk 6:17, 20-26

Jesus came down with the Twelve and stopped at a piece of level ground where there was a large gathering of his disciples with a great crowd of people from all parts of Judaea and from Jerusalem and from the coastal region of Tyre and Sidon who had come to hear him and to be cured of their diseases. Then fixing his eyes on his disciples he said: 'How happy are you who are poor: yours is the kingdom of God. Happy you who are hungry now: you shall be satisfied. Happy you who weep now: you shall laugh. 'Happy are you when people hate you, drive you out, abuse you, denounce your name as criminal, on account of the Son of Man. Rejoice when that day comes and dance for joy, for then your reward will be great in heaven. This was the way their ancestors treated the prophets. 'But alas for you who laugh now: you are having your consolation now. Alas for you who have your fill now: you shall go hungry. Alas for you who laugh now: you shall mourn and weep. 'Alas for you when the world speaks well of you! This was the way their ancestors treated the false prophets.'
