Plenary Council Listening and Dialogue Sessions. The Canberra Deanery held their first round of these sessions last week. In all, over 250 people of varying ages, professions and backgrounds participated in lively and sometimes passionate discussions. From these discussions there were some very clear local issues that are going to be submitted to the Plenary Council. These issues included the makeup of the Council itself, current Church governance, post Royal Commission issues, the role of the Church in Australia, roles within the Church especially including women and the marginalised, youth, education, social justice, ecumenism and evangelisation. From these discussions Draft submissions will be prepared locally and feedback sought before final submissions are posted.
