"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life".


Jesus came to earth and died on the cross to be with us. When Jesus did this, he took away everything that separates us from God.

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY - YEAR A Good SO LOVED the World that he gave his only Son


Draw Jesus talking to Nicodemus the pharisee.
