Synodality Resource: RESPONSES OF THE REFLECTIONS: Reflection: How do I recognise the voice of the Holy Spirit?

Prayer: Holy Spirit, help me to know and follow Your voice.

Everyone Has Gifts: The Holy Spirit gives different gifts to each of us. In a synodal Church we use these gifts with gratitude and humility, offering them for the service of Christ and the community. **Reflection:** What gifts has God given me to share with my parish? **Prayer:** Lord, teach me to use my gifts in service of others.

Walking in Humility: Synodality requires humility, patience, and a spirit of service. We look to Jesus who "emptied himself" in love and learn from His example. **Reflection:** How can I be humbler and patient in my relationships? **Prayer:** Jesus, give me a humble heart that reflects Your love.

ST. CARLO ACUTIS and ST. PIER GIORGIO FRASSATI: To thunderous applause from over 80,000 people—a great many of them young people—gathered in St. Peter's Square this Sunday morning, Pope Leo XIV declared Pier Giorgio Frassati, a young Italian from the 20th century who died at the age of 24, and Carlo Acutis, an Italian teenager from the 21st century, saints of the Catholic Church. "Sts Pier Giorgio Frassati and Carlo Acutis are an invitation to all of us, especially young people, not to squander our lives, but to direct them upwards and make them masterpieces," the pope said at the canonisation Mass on 7th September. "The simple but winning formula of their holiness," he said, is accessible to everyone at any time. "They encourage us with their words: 'Not I, but God,' as Carlo used to say. And Pier Giorgio: 'If you have God at the centre of all your actions, then you will reach the end.'"
