Parish Meeting convened on 7th July 2026 to present on the Affordable Housing Project and the associated implications. There were 35 parishioners and stakeholders in attendance.

Summary: 1) The meeting was chaired by Glenn Roff, the Chair of the Parish Pastoral Council (PPC). He spoke of the complexities associated with the development of such a project, the abiding good will, the commitments around consultation / transparency and the legitimate concerns of the Holy Trinity School / ELC community.

2) Anne Kirwin, the CEO of Marymead / CatholicCare, presented on the status of the project. She addressed erroneous myths that may have been circulating in the community. She also outlined, in broad terms, the criteria Marymead would utilize when accepting suitable tenants.

3) John Evers, Parish Finance Council (PFC) member, outlined the financial parameters of the project and how it would assist the long term viability of the Parish. This would include a more substantial budget for pastoral initiatives in the Parish.

4) Craig Perrett, the contracted Architect, presented a 3 dimensional representation of the design particularly specifying distances and sunlight parameters

5) Brendan Ryan, the Chair of the Parish Finance Council, then outlined the impact of the project on :

- a) The essential relocation of the Parish office
- b) The accommodation requirements of our Parish Priest
- c) The allowance of a private meeting room on the Curtin site.

There were a number of clarifying questions that were specifically directed to the appropriate presenter before Rob Shiner (the Deputy Chair of the PPC) concluded the meeting with a prayer for wisdom and the building of community. Glenn Roff (Chair of PPC).
