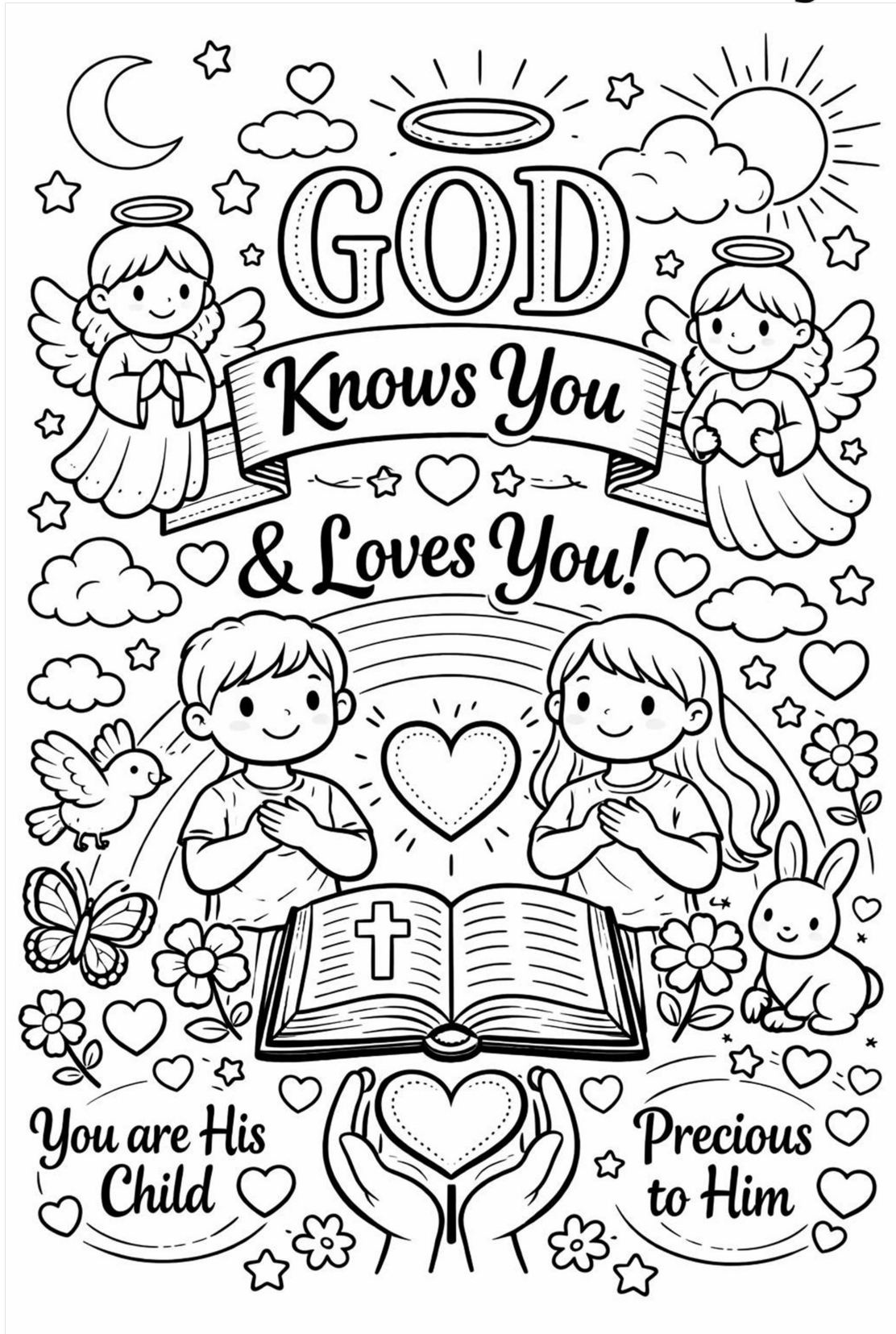

God knows and loves you



In the Gospel today (Matthew 10:25-33), Jesus is talking to His disciples before He sends them out to tell people about God. He knows that sometimes people will laugh at them, disagree with them, or make things difficult for them. So Jesus encourages them to be brave and trust in God.

Jesus tells them several times, "Do not be afraid." He says the same thing to us. He knows that everyone feels scared sometimes. We might be afraid of making mistakes, of speaking in front of others, or not understood or liked, of being left out, or of standing up for what is right. Jesus reminds us that God is always with us. When we trust God, we can be brave even when something feels difficult.

Jesus also tells His disciples, and us, to not keep the Good News about God's love a secret. The love of God is too wonderful to hide! He wanted the disciples to share His message with others. He wants us to do that too. We can share God's love by being kind, helping others, forgiving people, and talking about our faith when the opportunity comes.
