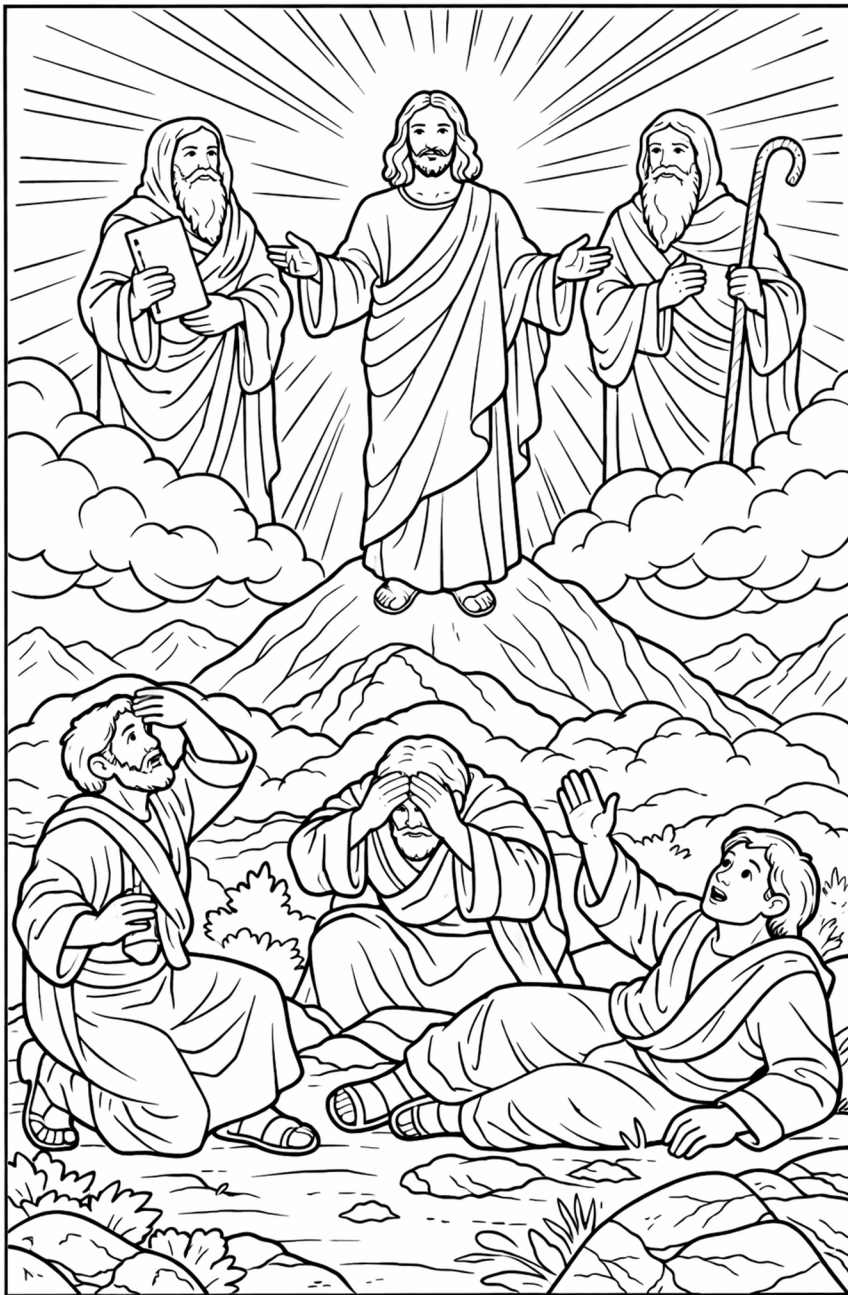

# Jesus is the son of God



Jesus takes three of his disciples - Peter, James and John - up a high mountain to pray. Suddenly, Jesus' appearance changes. His face shines like the sun, and his clothes become bright and dazzling white. This shows the disciples that Jesus is not just a teacher - he is truly God's son.

Two important people from the past, who had died, Moses and Elijah, appear and talk with Jesus. Peter is so amazed that he wants to build tents for them to stay! But while he is speaking, a bright cloud covers them, and they hear God say, "This is my beloved Son. Listen to him." God is telling them that Jesus has come with a special message and that they should pay attention to what he says.

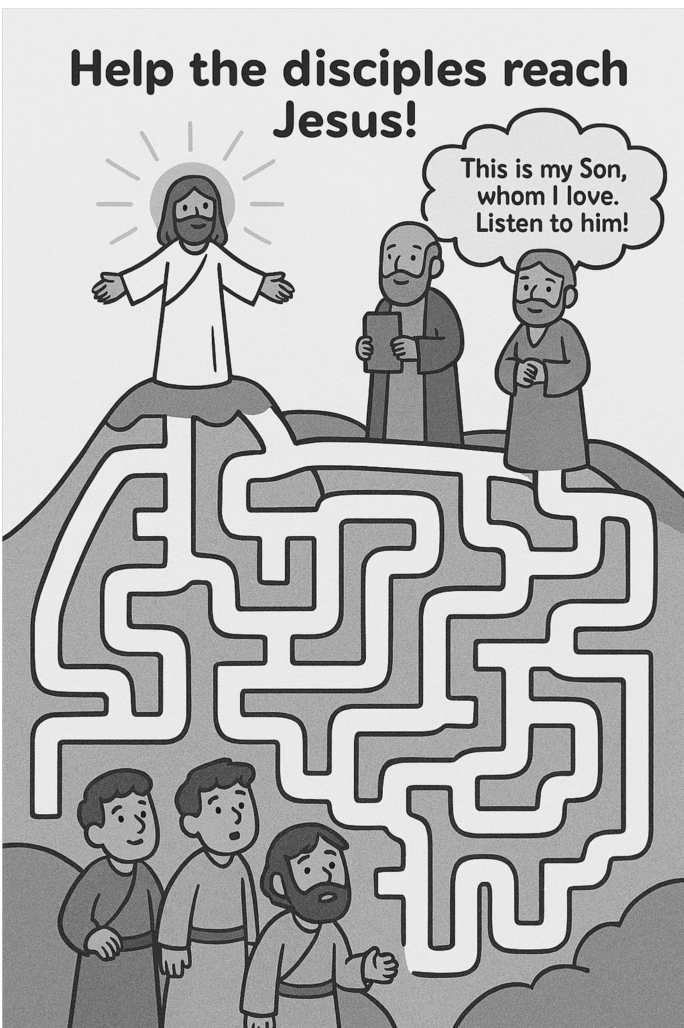
The disciples were afraid and fell to the ground. But Jesus comes to them, touches them, and says, "Do not be afraid." When they look up, only Jesus is there.
