One day, Jesus asked His friends a very important question: **“Who do you say I am?”** (Matthew 16:15).

Jesus wasn't asking if they knew His name. He was asking them who they believed Him to be. He wasn't asking them to give him the 'right' answer from what they had been taught or read. He wanted to know what they believed about Him.

Peter answered, “You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God.”

Peter recognised that Jesus was not just a man, not just a teacher or a great person. He recognised Jesus as the Son of God, who came to show us how much God loves us.

A prayer for this week

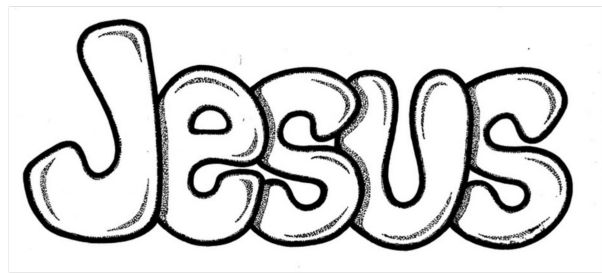
Take a quiet moment every day this week and talk to Jesus. Finish by praying:
